Visit to The National Holocaust Museum – Friday 27th October 2017

We have arranged a trip for the Year 6 classes to visit The National Holocaust Museum in Nottinghamshire. During the trip, we will be spending half a day in the exhibition and the other half listening to the testimony of a Holocaust survivor. During the exhibition, we will be learning about the life of a 10 year old German Jewish boy living in Berlin during the war. This trip will launch our second half of the topic 'A Child's War: What was life like for British and Jewish children during WWII?' focusing specifically on the lives of Jewish children in Europe.

The trip has been booked for Friday 27th October 2017 and we are asking you to make a contribution of £15.00 per child. Please make payment online via ParentPay by **MONDAY 9th OCTOBER 2017**.

Should insufficient payments be received the trip may be cancelled.

Children should arrive at school at 8.00am at the latest as we will be leaving school at 8.15am and children will arrive back at school to be collected at 3.15-3.30pm. Updates on arrival times will be sent via email/Twitter should we be delayed. Please provide a packed lunch on the day for your child (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal, then please let the office know in advance and a packed lunch can be provided for your child. Please provide a drink in a suitable container, even if you require a school packed lunch. The trip will go ahead whatever the weather and children will be predominantly inside but still provide suitable clothes, shoes and coats.
