**Visit to London – Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2018**

We have arranged an amazing educational trip for the Year 6 classes to visit The Natural History Museum and The Lyceum Theatre in London. During the trip, we will be able to explore the museum learning about huge mammals and exploring the amazing diversity of life on Earth. Children will also get to watch one of the greatest West End shows in London 'The Lion King' which will lead nicely into exploring the extreme habitats of African animals. This will provide us with outstanding writing opportunities for their writing assessments based on such a special trip and great memories.

The trip has been booked for Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2017 and we are asking you to make a **contribution of £35.00 per child**. Some of the cost has been subsidised by the school and we ask that payments are made via ParentPay. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, a discount has been applied and will be visible on your ParentPay payment item for this trip.

We appreciate this date may be sometime away, however in order to assist in budgeting we have made this available online so that payments can be made in instalments, if required, prior to Christmas pressures. Full payment should be made by **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2018**.

Should insufficient payments be received the trip may be cancelled.

Children should arrive at school at 6.50am on the morning as we will be leaving school at 7.00am and children will arrive back at school to be collected at approximately 8.00pm. Arrival times will be updated via Social Media. Please provide two packed lunches on the day for your child (no glass bottles please), one for lunch and one for tea. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, then please let the office know in advance and two packed lunches can be provided for your child. Please provide a drink in a suitable container, even if you require a school packed lunch. The trip will go ahead whatever the weather and children will be outside and indoors therefore suitable clothes, shoes and coats will be needed.
