IS YOUR JOINT FAMILY INCOME LESS THAN £16,190 PER YEAR?

YOU COULD RAISE EXTRA MONEY FOR YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL

Are you in receipt of any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit Run-On
- Universal Credit

Do you have a child who is: adopted, fostered, in temporary care or have a parent who is a member of the Armed Forces?

If yes, then the government will release an extra £1,300 to help support your child's school.

This money will be used to support extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.

Please support your school to provide the best educational experiences for your child.

If you answered yes to any of the above all you need to do is complete the attached form and return it to the School Office as soon as possible who will then pass the information onto Leicestershire County Council for assessment. It really is as simple as that and could make a real difference to school funding.
