Walking Home Procedures

We are aware that a number of children at Redlands walk to and/or from school unaccompanied. However, following the Safeguarding audit that all DSAT schools have recently undertaken, we will be asking all parents who allow their child(ren) this independence, to confirm this in writing to the school. This is to ensure that we are further safeguarding the needs of the children.

Although we fully support the parents' decisions regarding this, as we understand the need for children to develop independence and prepare for transition to secondary school, the school can only agree to a child walking home from school if they are in **Years 5 and 6**.

We are aware that a number of older children who walk home, may accompany a younger sibling who also attend Redlands. This will still be acceptable; however, the school must be aware of the details of this arrangement. If your child is in Years 5 and 6 and walks to and/or from school on their own, please complete the below form and return to the school by **Friday 23rd March 2018**.

If your child accompanies a younger sibling, please also complete this part of the form to ensure that the school are fully aware of the arrangements. **Younger siblings will not be permitted to leave with older siblings without this confirmation.**

From Monday 16th April, any child who has not returned the below form will not be dismissed from school unless a responsible adult comes to collect them.

We are aware that afterschool activities may change during the course of the academic year, which may affect your child's transport arrangement on these days. As always, ParentPay will request confirmation of how your child will get home following the end of an activities. If you choose to confirm that your child will walk home, they will only be allowed to do so should the school have confirmation of this via the attached form.

These permission forms will be issued at the beginning of each academic year, should you wish to change your child's travel arrangements during the year please contact the school office.
