Visit to Sealife Centre Birmingham –Tuesday 5th June 2018

We have arranged a trip for the Year 2 classes to visit the Sealife Centre in Birmingham in line with our Summer Term topic of 'Commotion in the Ocean'. During the trip we will explore and learn all about different creatures that live in our oceans. We will experience a talk and feeding demonstration, explore the interactive rock pool and become Sea Life Experts.

If you wish your child to participate, we will require a **non-refundable contribution of £16 by Friday 18th May 2018**. All payments can be made via ParentPay. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, a discount has been applied and will be visible on your ParentPay payment item for this trip.

Should insufficient payments be received the trip may be cancelled.

Children should arrive at school as normal in the morning as we will be leaving school at 9am and children will arrive back at school to be collected at 3.30pm. Please ensure that your child is in school uniform. The trip will go ahead whatever the weather and children will be outside therefore suitable clothes, shoes and coats will be needed.

As your child is entitled to a free school meal, please contact the School Office if your child will require a school packed lunch, please include a drink for your child even if you would like Redlands to provide your child's lunch. We ask that all drinks are not in glass bottles and that no fizzy drinks are included. Please remember that we have children and adults with an allergy to nuts.
