**Winter Wonderland at Twinlakes**  
**Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

With Christmas fast approaching, we are arranging a trip for the EYFS children to visit Twinlakes to experience the magic of the Winter Wonderland. During the trip the children will have access to the park, take part in festive workshops, Christmas hunts and reindeer feeding as well other festive fun!

Due to the differing heights of the children in our EYFS group, children will only be allowed to experience a few of the smaller rides. This ensures that all children have the same opportunity and experience whilst on the trip. Please be aware that as these rides are classed as toddler rides and adults are unable to accompany the children on the ride itself; however, the children will be supervised by a member of staff at all times. If you have any concerns about this, please speak to your child's class teachers.

The trip has been booked for Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2018. If you wish for your child to participate, we will require a **non-refundable contribution of £12.00 per child**. Please make payment via Parent Pay by **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2018**. **If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, a discount has been applied and will be visible on your ParentPay payment item for this trip.**

Should insufficient payments be received the trip may be cancelled.

Children should arrive at school as normal in the morning, as we will be leaving school at 9.15am. The children will arrive back at school at 3:00pm, to be collected at the normal time. Please ensure that your child is in the correct school uniform; the trip will go ahead whatever the weather and is outdoors therefore we ask that your child arrives at school wearing suitable clothes, shoes and coat.

As your child is entitled to a free school meal, please contact the School Office in advance if your child will require a school packed lunch. Please include a drink for your child even if you would like Redlands to provide your child's lunch. We ask that, if you choose to provide your child's lunch, no glass bottles or fizzy drinks are included. **Please remember that we have children and adults with an allergy to nuts so please check that food you are providing does not contain nut ingredients.**

As with all school trips, we adhere to strict ratios to ensure the safety of all staff and children. As a result of the higher ratios required in EYFS, we kindly ask for volunteers to offer their time to support us during this trip. If you wish to volunteer, please speak to your child's class teacher. Please note that parents who do volunteer will not be permitted to supervise their own child's group. This is to ensure adequate adult to child ratios are maintained throughout the trip.
