End of KS2
Tests and Teacher Assessment Results 2018

As you are aware, your child recently sat their end of Key Stage 2 tests and we are pleased to inform you that your child's Test Results and Teacher Assessment Results have now been published. We are very proud of what the children have achieved this past year and throughout their time at Redlands and it has been so positive to see them truly embracing learning.

How the tests are marked and scores awarded?

Your child's test papers were sent away for marking and the results were published electronically on 10th July 2018. The results will be reported using what's known as a scaled score, where a score below 100 indicates that a child needs more support, a score of 100 indicates that a child is working at the expected standard and a score of above 100 indicated that a child is working above expectations for their age. The maximum score possible is 120, and the minimum is 80.

It is important to keep in mind that these results only build part of the whole picture; teachers have also assessed your child based on how they have performed in the classroom over the last three years and since the new curriculum was introduced. Your child is assessed through these Teacher Assessments, along with the standardised tests, in order for the teacher's to have a guideline of comparison as to how your child is performing against a consistent national standard.

Please find the enclosed individual test and teacher assessment results for your child. We have also enclosed the school results for these assessments, to give you an idea of where your child's performance sits within the school's results as a whole.

We would to congratulate the children on completing the end of Key Stage 2; we are sure that the skills and learning that they have developed during their time at Redlands will support them as they move onto secondary education and achieving their full potential.

Thank you for your continued support and encouragement of your child's learning and for supporting Redlands in "working together and aiming for excellence".
