LOUGHBOROUGH TOWN SPORTS - LOUGHBOROUGH UNIVERSITY
SATURDAY 16th June (1pm onwards)

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your child's interest in the Loughborough Town Sports Athletics event on **Saturday 16th June 2018**. We believe this will be a great experience for all of the children involved and a fantastic opportunity to build their confidence and teambuilding skills. Following a discussion with the children, Redlands will be taking part in the following events: **Year 4:** 400m **Year 5:** 75m, 800m, **Year 6:** 50m, 75m, 800m. (please see the attached slip for which event your child will be competing in). Where children expressed an interest in doing more than one event, trials were held with Miss Gardner and Mr Roberts (Athletics Club).

Children need to arrive at the Loughborough University Athletics Track and meet with Mr Simpson for 12.45pm for an event start of 1pm. Gates will be open from 12.15pm and you will be able to park at Holywell Park located at the University, student from the Zambia Project will be on hand to assist. Please give yourselves plenty of time to arrive and park as the event is being attended by multiple schools. **The cost of entry is £2 per adult**, there is no cost for children/competitors.

Children will need to wear their school P.E Kit, but will also be provided with a Redlands top upon arrival (*Please ensure that tops are returned to Mr Simpson before you leave the event*). Children will need to attach a number to their t-shirt using safety pins - please try to bring your own safety pins as they are not provided at the event. All children must wear trainers (or running spikes if they have them). Please make sure your child has a drink of water and suitable clothing depending on the weather. Once your child has competed in their event, you are welcome to take them home.

St John's Ambulance will be present at the event and refreshments will also be available to purchase.

Due to the event taking place on a Saturday you will need to arrange your own transport for your child. An adult will also need to stay at the event and be responsible for your child and they must be supervised at all times and remain on the grass bank when they are not competing. Please return the below reply slip by **Wednesday 13th June** to confirm your child's attendance at the tournament.



As the children will be representing the school at this event, we ask that the children keep in mind the Redlands R's and maintain a supportive and respectful attitude towards each other and the other teams taking part in the tournament.
