Swimming Lessons

We would like to inform you that swimming lessons have been arranged for Mrs Lamble's/Mrs Wallis' class at South Charnwood Leisure Centre. Lessons will run for a total of 9 weeks starting on **Wednesday 15th November 2017** and will be as follows:

Please Note: From January swimming lessons will change to Mondays

Please keep this letter for reference of the dates for swimming as there won't be a reminder issued. The children will be collected from school after morning registration at 9.00am, please can you make sure that children arrive at school on time as the bus will leave promptly and if children are late they will not be able to attend the lesson. Children will arrive back in school at 10.30am. We are using Total Travel for transport and the children will be accompanied at all times by school staff.

The children will require the following which must be clearly named and in a suitable bag. Leicestershire Education Authority recommends that the children do not wear goggles because they carry considerable risks. Please talk to Mr Brown if this is a problem for your child.

- ✓ A one-piece swimming costume or trunks (not baggy swim shorts or shorts)
- ✓ A towel
- ✓ Brush or comb
- ✓ Bag for kit

For safety reasons the children must not bring any kind of spray or deodorant etc and must not wear jewellery e.g. earrings (we cannot remove earrings for your child). If your child is asthmatic and requires an inhaler it must be available in school and taken to the swimming pool.

Swimming is a curriculum activity and we do not ask for payment for this, however we do provide transport to and from these sessions and therefore we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£4.00 for each session**. You can pay this weekly on a Wednesday or **£36.00 for the full course of 9 lessons** (in the event of a cancellation we will refund the amount to you at the end of the course). Please make payment via ParentPay, either weekly or for the full amount. **If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, a discount has been applied and will be visible on your ParentPay payment item.**

You will have received a form with this letter asking if your child swims or is a non-swimmer. This form **MUST** be sent back to School by **Friday 10th November 2017**. School must receive this completed form before your child(ren) will be allowed to attend the swimming lessons.

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Swimming Goggles Permission

The recommendation by the Local Education Authority is that children do not wear goggles because they do carry considerable risks. They are of the opinion that the hazards to the child and others are probably far in excess of a genuine need for protection. The risks include:

- Goggles of a cheaper variety may shatter in the event of a collision and may result in serious injury.
- Children using goggles do not always understand the correct way of putting them on and taking them off. Cold slippery fingers do not grasp the fittings adequately and a catapult effect can result in eye trauma.
- It is difficult to maintain accurately fitting eye protection therefore contact with water in the swimming pool is almost inevitable.

If you wish your child to wear goggles, please read and sign the following declaration.

I have read and understood the dangers. I accept responsibility for:

- Buying British Institute Kite-Marked swimming goggles.
- Ensuring that my child is trained in the wearing of swimming goggles.

Please note that the teacher in charge will take goggles off your child if they are not being used in the correct manner.
