Sports Day Update Tuesday 2nd July 2019

With Sports Day only days away and next week set to be another scorcher, we would like to take this opportunity to highlight some important messages ahead of the events.

Timings

EYFS and KS1 **9.30am-11am** – Parents can wait on the school field after drop off where refreshments will be available from FORs.

KS2 **1.30pm-3pm** – Please arrive no earlier than 1.30pm – entry via school office gate entrance.
(Special Guest appearance from LCFC Filbert the Fox)

As in previous years, we are having a '**wear your P.E Kit Day**' and the children will move around the course in their school houses of Ladkin, Melody, Newbold and Whitehead. To support the children in displaying the Redlands R's and have Respect for their team, we are asking that all children wear a t-shirt in their house colour – **Ladkin - Green, Melody – Red, Newbold – Yellow, Whitehead – Blue**. **If your child does not know which house they are in, please speak to their class teachers.**

Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing and footwear for the days' activities and, although we are hoping that the weather to be glorious and hot, please send in appropriate clothing for all weather conditions; in particular, please ensure your child has a jacket (not coat). For those children who cannot remove earrings, we ask that parents provide microporous tape to cover them up.

With the forecast predicting for temperatures upwards of 18 degrees, please ensure that you send your children to school with pre-applied sun-screen, hats and plenty to drink. Please remember the SunSmart campaign SLIP-SLOP-SLAP. You may send your child to school with extra sun-screen which your child will need to apply themselves; this must be hypoallergenic and we ask that all sun-screen is clearly labelled with your child's name and handed to the class teacher at the start of the day.



We look forward to welcoming you all to join us for these special events, but would ask that you respect the following:

- Please remember that parking on school premises is not permitted, should you need to travel by car, please park safely and courteously away from school.
- Spectators are to use the **disabled toilet ONLY** in the Year 5/6 block during the event.
- Please remember that although photography is permitted, it is essential that **NO images** including other children are uploaded onto social media sites, as not all children have permission for this.
- Please do not ask to leave and re-enter the school for cigarette breaks or enter any other classrooms.

As in previous years, Friends of Redlands are happy to be supporting the school at this event by providing cold refreshments for those who attend. Any money raised will be used to support the school in providing new resources for the children.
