Visit to Warning Zone – Thursday 7th June 2018

Children in Year 6 are encouraged to experience several scenarios in which they meet dangers and obstacles in an everyday context, Warning Zone are a charitable company who have a pre-set environment in which these scenarios can be experienced in a safe and supportive manner. With this in mind, we have arranged for our Year 6 to participate in a great opportunity by visiting Warning Zone.

The trip has been booked for **Thursday 7th June** and we are asking for a **non-refundable contribution of £10.00 per child**. Redlands has subsidised this cost as we believe that this is such an amazing learning experience and all of the children return with positive memories. All payments can be made via ParentPay. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, a discount has been applied and will be visible on your ParentPay payment item for this trip.

Children should arrive at school as normal in the morning as we will be leaving school at 9.30am and children will arrive back at school to be collected at 3.15pm as usual. Please ensure that your child is in school uniform. The trip will go ahead whatever the weather and although children will be inside for the majority of the trip suitable clothes, shoes and coats will be needed. If the forecast is for sunny weather, please provide a hat and ensure the children come to school with sun cream on.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please contact the School Office if your child will require a school packed lunch, please include a drink for your child (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please) even if you would like Redlands to provide your child's lunch. We ask that, if you choose to provide your child's lunch, no glass bottles or fizzy drinks are included. Please remember that we have children and adults with an allergy to nuts.
