## Road safety and behaviour

We expect all Redlands children to display the Redlands R's while walking to and from school, particularly **RESPECT** – respect for the crossing patrol, other road users, pedestrians, and other children walking to and from school. For those children who walk without an adult, we expect you to behave responsibly and set a good example for our younger children.

After children have entered through the school gate, they should remain within the school grounds.

We have been made aware of an incident with children going in through the gates in the morning, then coming back out and throwing fruit into the road and running into the road after it. These children are putting their own safety at risk, as well as other road users.

**Parents and carers – please discuss road safety and behaviour going to and from school with your children. It is imperative that they understand the dangers associated with poor behaviour near and on roads.**

**School opens** | The school gates open at 8:40am. Children are the responsibility of the parent until 8:45am and must be supervised on the playground.

**Contacting a teacher** | If you wish to talk to a class teacher during the school day then please call and make an appointment.
