Childcare vouchers

When making a payment with childcare vouchers, confirmation from the providers can take up to two days to be received in the school office. The office then requires two to three school days to process the funds.

This process is made faster if the office is already aware of how you want your funds allocated. Please email the office as soon as you make a payment through your provider, detailing how you need these funds to be allocated.

Please note, that any bookings made before payment is allocated, may result in sessions being cancelled without notification. With this in mind, please ensure that you make payment well in advance, and bear in mind that the school office is closed during the weekends and school holidays. Please feel free to contact the school office if you have any questions regarding this.

Yellow zig-zag lines outside schools indicate the length of road where stopping or waiting is strictly prohibited. Please bear in mind the safety of our school families, staff, and our local community and park sensibly, safely and legally.
